Elements of art are: color, form, line, shape, space, texture, and value

Where do you notice those elements?

What do you think will be the most challenging part of recreating your picture?






Finish small sketches, piece picture together Provide PEER FEEDBACK on how what could be made better, what should be changed, what works, etc.

Layout all large pieces of paper for final piece

Decide if any pieces need to be trimmed

Begin sketching the large version of your section

As a group, decide what media you will use to add color to your picture. Choose at LEAST 3. Media choices: Paint (watercolor, acrylic), oil pastels, colored pencils, marker, crayons, chalk pastels



PEER FEEDBACK

FEEDBACK DO'S:

Be specific in your critique

Use "art" words, i.e. "I don't think that's the right *color* for that spot," or "there could be more *movement* with the *lines* in this section."

Focus on the art, not the artist

Leave personal issues/emotion out of your critiques
